Kinderhaus Building

Originally constructed circa 1817, Kinderhaus is the oldest building on the campus of the School and now serves as home to the Department of School History. Kinderhaus (German for children's home), was originally a stone farmhouse built by Isaac Hershey, Milton Hershey's great-grandfather. Milton Hershey purchased the home and surrounding farm in 1906 and used the property to house students beginning in 1912.

MHS Campus Tour

Milton Hershey School is a cost-free, private, coeducational school in Hershey, PA. We offer state-of-the-art facilities, advanced technology and hundreds of extracurricular activities. Milton and Catherine Hershey established the school in 1909 to provide a positive, structured home life year-round to help children gain the skills to be successful in all aspects

of life. Today, more than 2,000 students from across the U.S. attend Milton Hershey School. They have access to unique award-winning programs, experienced teachers and caring adult mentors.
